RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the "Modification Nos. 2 and 3 to Contract NFPHC-NUR-23-C-00039 between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation and Aya Healthcare, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2025". Sec. 2. (a) There exists an immediate need to approve Modification Nos. 2 and 3 to Contract NFPHC-NUR-23-C-00039 Modifications ("Contract") between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation ("Hospital") and Aya Healthcare, Inc. for the provision of supplemental staffing in nursing, and to authorize payment for the services received and to be received under this Contract.

- 38 (b) The Council approved the Base Year contract on December 22, 2022, for the amount of \$6,000,000.00 (CA24-0763).
- 40 (c) The Council partially approved Option Year 1 (Modifications #1) on January
 41 1, 2024,) for the amount of \$2,500,000.00 (CA25-0573).

- (d) If Proposed Modification #2 is approved for \$3,200,000.00, the revised total retroactive value of the Option year 1 (January 3, 2024 January 2, 2025) would have an aggregate value of \$5,700,000.00. This amount would exceed \$1 million in a 12-month period, and therefore Council approval is necessary.
 - (e) If Proposed Modification #3 exercising part of Option Year 2 (January 3, 2025 through March 31,2025) is approved for \$1,200,000.00, it would have an aggregate value that exceeds \$1 million in a 12-month period; therefore, Council approval is necessary.
- (f) Without this approval, Aya Healthcare, Inc. cannot be paid for these critical services provided and to be provided in excess of \$999,999.99.
 - Sec. 3. The Council determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that Modification Nos. 2 and 3 to Contract NFPHC-NUR-23-C-00039 between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation and Aya Healthcare, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2025, be adopted after a single reading.
- Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
