This memorandum serves as my request to agendize the following measures for the February 4, 2025 Regular Legislative Meeting:

Emergency and Temporary Legislation

- Youth Workforce Development Programs Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2025
- Youth Workforce Development Programs Emergency Amendment Act of 2025
- Youth Workforce Development Programs Temporary Amendment Act of 2025

This measure would modify the permissible use of Department of Employment Services funds relating to food and non-alcoholic beverage purchases for workforce development program events to ensure that funds are used to feed participants in the programs. The bill also expands the definition of a "covered child or youth services provider" in § 4-1501.02 to include employees or volunteers of host employers participating in these summer youth programs to make them subject to background and motor vehicle record checks. The bill also authorizes the Department of Employment Services to conduct these background checks of those employees or volunteers of host employers or grantees with direct contact or unsupervised access to youth participating in the programs.

Confirmation Resolutions

 PR26-0021 – Office of Employee Appeals Pia Winston Confirmation Resolution of 2025

PR26-0021 would appoint Pia Winston to the Office of Employee Appeals for a term to end on April 6, 2030. On October 1, 2024, Chairman Mendelson referred PR25-0987, now PR26-0021, to the Committee on Executive Administration and Labor. On November 22, 2024, the Committee held a public Roundtable on PR25-0987. On January 7, 2025, the Council Period 26 version of the resolution (PR26-0021) was referred to the Committee on Executive

Administration and Labor. On January 27, 2025, the Committee held an Organizational Meeting at which the measure was approved unanimously.
