A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To amend, on a temporary basis, , the Secure DC Omnibus Amendment Act of 2024 to remove the sunset date of certain pretrial detention provisions; and to amend the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council for the District of Columbia Establishment Act of 2001 to clarify certain reporting requirements.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Secure DC Pretrial Detention Extension and Reporting Temporary Amendment Act of 2025”.

Sec. 2. The Secure DC Omnibus Amendment Act of 2024, effective June 8, 2024 (D.C. Law 25-175; 71 DCR 2732), is amended as follows:

- (a) Section 18(c)(2) is repealed.
- (b) Section 30(k) is repealed.

Sec. 3. Section 1505 of the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council for the District of Columbia Establishment Act of 2001, effective October 3, 2001 (D.C. Law 14-28; D.C. Official Code § 22-4234), is amended as follows:

- (a) Subsection (b-9) is amended as follows:
 - (1) The lead-in language is amended by striking the phrase “no later than 180 days after the applicability date of section 30(f), (g), and (h) of the Secure DC Omnibus

34 345) (“Secure DC Omnibus”)” and inserting the phrase “no later than May 7, 2025” in its place.

69 Sec. 4. Applicability.

70 This act shall apply as of January 1, 2025.

71 Sec. 5. Fiscal impact statement.

72 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Budget Director as the fiscal impact
73 statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved
74 October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

75 Sec. 6. Effective date.

76 (a) This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by
77 the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review

78 as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
79 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
80 Columbia Register.

81 (b) This act shall expire after 225 days of its having taken effect.
