Council Chairman Phil Mendelson announces a public roundtable before the Committee of the Whole on Student Voices on Education in the District. The public roundtable will be held at **4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, March 18, 2025.** 

The purpose of this roundtable is to provide District students with a venue to share their views on public education based on their educational experience. The Committee of the Whole conducts oversight of education agencies, forms budgets for those agencies, and passes legislation to direct agency actions to improve outcomes for District students. To that end, the Committee is interested in hearing about what students think of the quality of their education and the culture of their schools. More specifically, the Committee is concerned with what students think of their curriculum, enrichment opportunities, relationships with their teachers and other staff, support for mental health, other challenges students face, or other topics that students see as crucial to their success in school.

Testimony is limited to three minutes. We will make every effort to fulfill timely requests, although alternatives may be offered. Requests received in less than five business days may not be fulfilled. Witnesses will receive instructions on how to participate by Zoom prior to the hearing.
