WHEREAS, in his rookie season with the Commanders, Daniels set an NFL rookie and team record with a 91.3% completion percentage on 23 attempts in a game against the Cincinnati Bengals, amassing 293 total yards and three touchdowns, earning him NFC Offensive Player of the Week honors; WHEREAS, Daniels was named NFL Offensive Rookie of the Month for September 2024, being the first Washington Commander to win it since Robert Griffin III in 2012; WHEREAS, during the 2024 regular season, Jayden Daniels completed 69% of his passes for 3,568 yards, threw 25 touchdowns, and rushed for 891 yards and 6 touchdowns, showcasing his dual-threat capabilities; WHEREAS, he became the third rookie in NFL history to pass for over 3,000 yards and rush for over 600 yards in a season, as well as the fifth player and first rookie to have four games with a completion percentage of at least 80% in a season; WHEREAS, Daniels set the NFL record for most rushing yards in a season by a rookie

 quarterback and led the Commanders to their first playoff win since 2005 and first NFC Championship Game appearance since 1991;
