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15 To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Modification
16 Nos. M02, M03, and M04 and proposed Modification No. M05 to Contract No.
17 DCAM-24-NC-RFP-0003A, between the Department of General Services and
18 Jerome L. Taylor Trucking, Inc. to provide citywide solid waste (trash and
19 recycling) collection and disposal services at various facilities located throughout
20 the District of Columbia, as well as five (5) collection points in the State of
21 Maryland, requiring front-load, rear-load and roll-off containers, and to authorize
22 payment for goods and services received and to be received under these
23 modifications.
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25 RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, that this
26 resolution may be cited as the “Modification Nos. M02, M03, and M04 and proposed
27 Modification No. M05 to Contract No. DCAM-24-NC-RFP-0003A with Jerome L. Taylor
28 Trucking, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of
29 2025”.

30 Sec. 2 (a) There exists an immediate need to approve Modification Nos. M02, M03,
31 and M04 and proposed Modification No. M05 to Contract No. DCAM-24-NC-RFP-0003A
32 (the “Contract”) for citywide solid waste collection and disposal services, between the
33 Department of General Services (the “Department”) and Jerome L. Taylor Trucking, Inc.
34 (the “Contractor”), to increase the aggregate not-to-exceed (“NTE”) amount of Option

35 Year One to \$4,113,054.36, and to authorize payment to the Contractor for services
36 received and to be received under these modifications.

37 (b) On September 11, 2024, via Modification No. M02, the Department partially
38 exercised Option Year One of the Contract, extending the term of the Contract from
39 October 1, 2024, through November 18, 2024, and establishing a NTE amount of
40 \$937,087.38.

41 (c) On November 18, 2024, via Modification No. M03, the Department extended
42 the Option Year One period through February 24, 2025 at no additional cost.

43 (d) On January 13, 2025, via Modification No. M04, the Department extended the
44 Option Year One period through April 14, 2025 at no additional cost.

45 (e) Proposed Modification No. M05 would exercise the remainder of Option Year
46 One, extending the term of the Contract through September 30, 2025, and increasing the
47 NTE amount for Option Year One by \$3,175,966.98, from \$937,087.38 to \$4,113,054.36.

48 (f) Modification Nos. M02, M03, and M04 and proposed Modification No. M05
49 will fully exercise Option Year One, increasing the total NTE amount of Option Year One
50 of the Contract by an amount in excess of \$1 million; thus, Council approval of the
51 proposed contract action is required pursuant to section 451 of the District of Columbia
52 Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-
53 204.51).

54 (g) Approval of Modification Nos. M02, M03, and M04 and proposed Modification
55 No. M05 is necessary to authorize the continuation of citywide solid waste collection and
56 disposal services and to compensate the Contractor for services provided and to be
57 provided under these modifications.

58 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances
59 enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the
60 Modification Nos. M02, M03, and M04 and proposed Modification No. M05 to Contract
61 No. DCAM-24-NC-RFP-0003A with Jerome L. Taylor Trucking, Inc. Approval and
62 Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2025 be adopted after a single reading.
