22	amended as follows:
23	(a) Subparagraph (A) is amended by striking the phrase "prior to the effective date of the
24	Second Chance Amendment Act of 2022, passed on 2nd reading on December 20, 2022
25	(Enrolled version of Bill 24-63)" and inserting the phrase "on or before September 30, 2027" in
26	its place.
27	(b) Subparagraph (B) is amended by striking the phrase "the effective date of the Second
28	Chance Amendment Act of 2022, on 2nd reading on December 20, 2022 (Enrolled version of
29	Bill 24-63), shall be sealed" and inserting the phrase "October 1, 2027, shall be sealed by
30	October 1, 2027, or" in its place.
