Dear Chairman Mendelson,

During the February 28<sup>th</sup> Performance Oversight Hearing for the District of Columbia Public Schools, you requested additional information on several topics. You also wrote to me recently requesting responses to additional questions prior to the Performance Oversight Hearing. Please see DCPS's responses to your requests below.

### **Immunization Rates**

To prevent the spread of infectious diseases, all students must be fully immunized. Immunizations are the best defense against some of the most common and sometimes deadly infectious diseases. DCPS works closely with DC Health and the Office of the State Superintendent of Education to encourage immunization and track immunizations. DC Health provided the data below on March 4<sup>th</sup>. The data below describes students who have received the recommended dose(s) of vaccine. To optimize prevention of vaccine preventable disease outbreaks, national public health practice recommends vaccination coverage of at least 95% for all vaccines. The 95% threshold refers to the percentage of a population that needs to be vaccinated against a disease to achieve herd immunity and best protect the community from an outbreak with potentially fatal outcomes. DC, like most of the country, experienced dramatic declines in routine pediatric immunizations during the pandemic from 2020-2021. To improve immunization coverage rates, DC Health, OSSE, and all school partners developed and implemented a comprehensive approach to increase pediatric immunization coverage with immunization compliance as a focal point. DC Health recommends students be up to date with immunizations according to this [schedule](#). Note the 2<sup>nd</sup> dose of Meningococcal ACWY is recommended at age 16, but most students are not vaccinated until they start 11<sup>th</sup> grade. This accounts for the lower average across 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grades in comparison to other vaccines like HPV where students can get a 2nd dose as soon as six months after the first dose (while still in middle school).

### **Teacher Retention**

Retaining educators, especially the most effective educators, is of paramount importance to DCPS. We are proud of the fact that 89% of teachers returned to DCPS this past fall and that we retain over 90% of our most effective teachers. The Committee requested we calculate the retention rate from the 2022-2023 school year through the 2023-2024 school year. DCPS calculated this retention rate by determining the number of teachers at each school on October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022 and then calculating the number of those teachers still working at that school as a teacher on October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024. DCPS did not include teachers still working at that school in another role. The table below includes both the retention rate and the number of teachers for each school. As stated during the hearing, DCPS tracks retention of teachers overall and retention of teachers rated effective and highly effective. Both retention rates are included for reference.

### Explanation of School Budgets





For School Year 2025-2026 (Fiscal Year 2026), DC Public Schools continues to distribute resources to align with the academic, social, and emotional needs of students. Schools receive funding aligned to their student enrollment and level of need, with additional funds allocated to support students with greater needs. Budget allocations prioritize classroom teachers, ensuring that funding for teaching and learning is paramount in a tight financial landscape. A new School Sustainability Fund will enable each DCPS school to maintain appropriate teacher-to-student ratios and adequate staffing. School budget worksheets reflect projected student enrollment and factor required teacher-to-student ratios across the district.

Enrollment projections are predictions of future enrollment at each school on the annual enrollment audit date of the subsequent school year, usually October 5<sup>th</sup>. DCPS analyzes past enrollment trends to predict total enrollment at each school, enrollment of students who receive special education services, enrollment of students who meet at-risk criteria, and enrollment of students who are Multilingual learners. At the six schools of interest to the Committee, due to reductions in their projected enrollment, fewer resources are being allocated at five of the six schools. Each school is projected to see fewer students attending the school in School Year 2025 – 2026, with reductions ranging from 4% to 28%. At Tubman ES, Dunbar HS, Jackson-Reed HS, and King ES, current enrollment is below the projections from FY25 and FY26 is projected to be even lower. We are moving our virtual programming from Luke C Moore HS and Ballou STAY fully to Garnet-Patterson STAY. While each school will need fewer staff to educate a smaller student population, we agree with the DC Council that students benefit when school budgets are stable. Therefore, the School Sustainability Fund ensures that budget reductions are significantly smaller than the projected enrollment decreases, with total budget changes ranging from 0.3% to 6.9%. ### **Medicaid Billing**



The District of Columbia's Medicaid program allows reimbursement for medically necessary School-Based Health Services provided to Medicaid-eligible students between the ages of three and twenty-two. For LEAs to successfully bill Medicaid claims for covered services, the following requirements must be met:

1. The student receiving the service must be enrolled in the Medicaid program.
2. The student must qualify for services under the IDEA.
3. The student must have an IEP.
4. The services must be specified in the IEP and/or assessments/evaluations.
5. The services must be furnished by a related service provider who meets the Medicaid-qualified provider criteria and who is qualified to provide the service under applicable State licensure or certification requirements and have an NPI.
6. The LEA must obtain a one-time signed parental consent to bill Medicaid for covered IEP services provided to the student.

DCPS receives two types of payments from Medicaid – (1) ongoing payments for Medicaid claims and (2) a lump sum payment resulting from a triennial audit by the Center for Medicaid and Medicare Services (CMS). Because the CMS audit is conducted every three years, the payment is for services provided in the past. In addition to CMS, the District's Department of Health Care Finance (DHCF) conducts an audit on Medicaid providers each year.

The reimbursement rate is set by the state Medicaid agency, DC Healthcare Finance. Claims are paid out at a base rate of 70%, with some rates varying by specialty as determined by the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP). During the Covid-19 national health emergency, the federal government ordered all Medicaid reimbursement rates be raised by 6.2% and DCPS Medicaid claims were paid out at a rate of 76.2% until the conclusion of the national health emergency in May 2023. ### **Substitute Requests**

Every time a school's assigned timekeeper requests a substitute for one day of coverage, that request is either then filled or unfilled. The table below shows the number and percentage of filled and unfilled requests. In the context of substitute teacher coverage, a filled request means that a Substitute Teacher was successfully assigned to provide coverage for a vacancy or absence for a teacher or educational aide. An unfilled request means that the school's coverage need was not met by a substitute teacher. In these cases, schools rely on educators within the building to provide coverage and compensate them according to established rates within collective bargaining agreements.

DCPS Central Services staff recently contacted the Parent Teacher Organization at LaSalle-Backus to provide information about the school's modernization.

### **Afterschool Sign-Ups**

DCPS has worked closely with government partners, including the Deputy Mayor for Education, the Office of Out of School Time Grants and Youth Outcomes, and the Department of Parks and Recreation to create *My Out-Of-School-Time DC (MOST-DC)*, a centralized portal where families can explore available out of school time programming beyond the school day, including before-school, after-school, and summer programming. The [MOST-DC portal](#) launched on March 19<sup>th</sup> and will be the sole host for DCPS' SY25-26 out-of-school-time program registration starting this May. On this portal, parents can create a profile and link each of their children, allowing them to easily apply for programming. When registration opens, parents will click apply to register and follow the instructions in the portal. Students who are registered after seats are filled will automatically go into a waitlist for their selected program. Parents are notified of status by email and text and as updates occur. If a seat opens, the next child will move into the available seat.

### **FTEs on Central and School Support Budgets**

DCPS is continuing to work closely with the Office of the Chief Financial Officer on the request to provide additional information about the number of staff budgeted centrally for prior fiscal years.

- 42. Please provide an accounting of all policy and personnel changes made in the past year to improve contract and procurement procedures at DCPS.**

Since DCPS became aware of procurement challenges, especially related to procurement over one million dollars, which requires Council approval, DCPS has dedicated additional resources to strengthen its oversight, evaluation, and operation of its procurement program. DCPS relies heavily on its procurement division to provide resources to support the 117 schools in its portfolio and associated central services program necessary to ensure academic and social success for our students.

In Spring 2023 DCPS began implementing acquisition planning to better inform future procurement planning and we continue to refine the process. Once high value procurements are





determined and the procurement process is initiated, the procurements are tracked on a weekly basis and reported to leadership and the City Administrator's office. DCPS Office leaders are required to conduct annual acquisition planning that coincides with the budget approval process and quarterly certify any procurement needs over \$100,000. The DCPS operational finance team, in partnership with the procurement team, routinely follows up on planned procurements by conducting weekly meetings to discuss current statuses. DCPS has reinforced the use of milestone charts to internally track procurements over \$100,000. DCPS closely monitors any procurements exceeding \$500,000 and has updated its internal SharePoint files and contract package checklist to ensure that documents are maintained as required.

Currently, key vacancies on the Contracts and Acquisitions (C&A) team have been filled, additional procedures and training have been developed, oversight tools have been implemented, and management of the division has been shifted within the DCPS organization to provide added oversight. DCPS has also implemented a quality assurance program managed by DCPS staff outside the Contracting and Procurement Division, who are responsible for auditing procurements and assisting with the implementation of recommendations to support that division.

Contracts and Acquisitions utilizes the Procurement Manual to streamline processes and implement best practices within the division. The department is currently reviewing the Procurement Manual to make updates for the second version. Additionally, C&A is collaborating with a vendor to create a SPO (Sourcing and Procurement Operations) platform. This platform will allow both end users (i.e. school staff) and the C&A division to work on requests simultaneously, and it will enable end users to submit and track their requests within the platform.

In the past, staff turnover has been higher than optimal within DCPS Contracts & Acquisitions. However, in FY25, DCPS aggressively recruited and filled vacancies which were two Contract Specialist positions and two Senior Contract Specialist positions. In both units, Contracts and Acquisitions promoted internal candidates into those roles. Additionally, the Program Specialist position in the Procurement Operations unit was filled. DCPS Contracts and Acquisitions is now in the selection phase for the one current vacant position and will continue to recruit aggressively whenever additional vacancies arise.

DCPS C&A maintains a consistent process for evaluating and providing managers with contracting authority at various dollar thresholds. DCPS has worked to add personnel with extensive contracting experience. The Contracts Director has received contracting authority from OCP, bringing the total number of individuals with contracting authority in the division to four. This effort aims to better distribute the workload among staff, and DCPS continues to evaluate opportunities for further improvements. In addition, DCPS will continue issuing contract warrants as appropriate while ensuring a high level of control over contract execution.

DCPS continues to use and reference the first version of its procurement procedures manual within the division. This manual has also been shared with the Core Team to provide standardized guidance and has supported CASK in creating the SPO. C&A staff have received training on various procurement topics. C&A is currently preparing updates for the second version of the Procurement Manual and has developed job aides to support the implementation of daily job tasks. Finally, our quality assurance process—which includes conducting external





reviews of at least 10% of all procurements—will continue to reinforce proper procurement procedures.

Contracts and Acquisitions concluded FY24 with 100% completion of all performance evaluation cycles. As of January 2025, DCPS Contracts and Acquisitions has also achieved 100% compliance in conducting mid-year performance evaluations. Moving forward, OFS leadership will continue to emphasize and closely monitor performance reviews, including documenting adherence to the performance management process in management evaluations.

During SY21-22, SY22-23, and SY23-24, and SY 24-25, DPCS received funding through the Office of Head Start to serve 250 Head Start eligible children and families, and DCPS has enrolled and is serving 250 Head Start eligible children.

**Which schools are DCPS Head Start schools?**

The DCPS Head Start schools are CW Harris, Hendley, Kimball, King, Savoy, and Stanton.

**Does DCPS plan to expand Head Start?**

SY 25-26 will be the 5<sup>th</sup> year of DCPS's 5-year Head Start grant. Next spring, DCPS plans to apply for another 5-year grant. DCPS is considering whether to request a grant that serves a larger number of students while ensuring we can meet all requirements related to the federal grant in all Head Start Schools.



### **How do we determine which students are enrolled in Head Start?**

In alignment with the Head Start Program Performance Standards, DCPS uses established selection criteria to determine which students are enrolled in Head Start. In alignment with Head Start standards, these criteria include family income, whether the child is homeless, the child's age, whether the child is in foster care, whether the child is eligible for special education and related services, or early intervention services, and other relevant family or child risk factors.

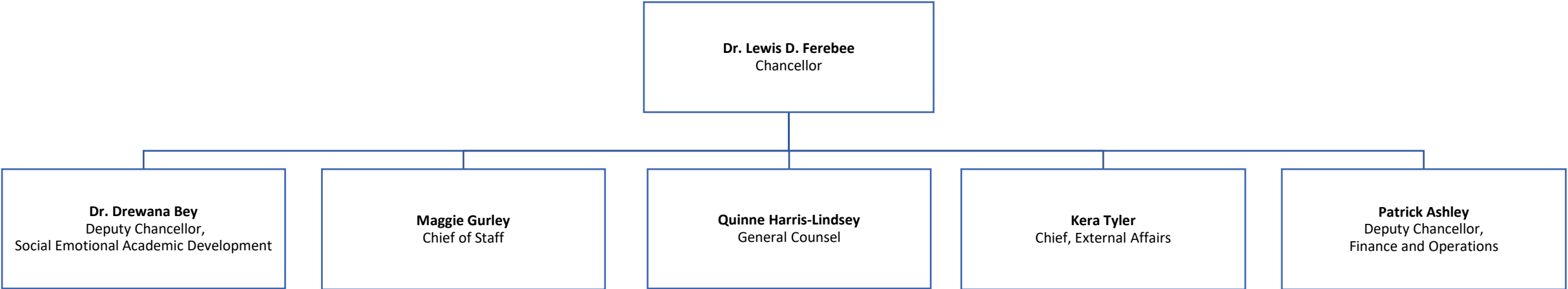

# Post-POH Attachment Q01 DC Public Schools Organizational Chart

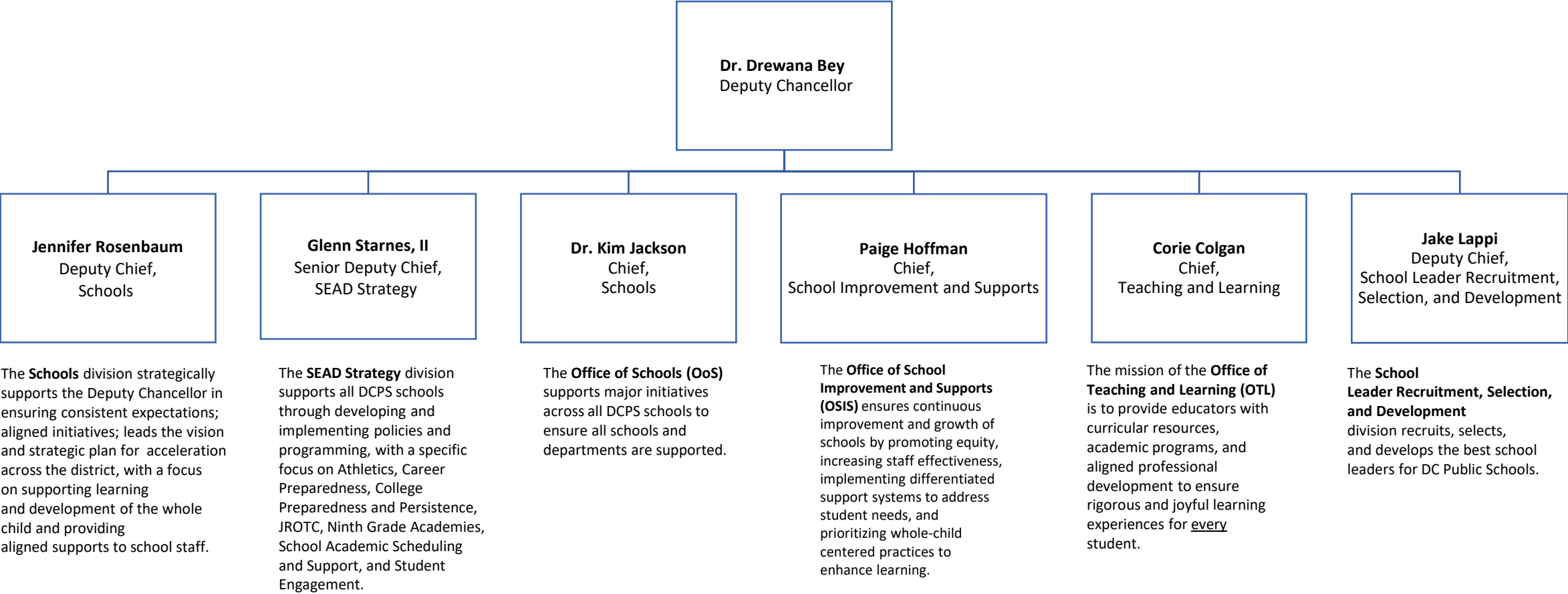

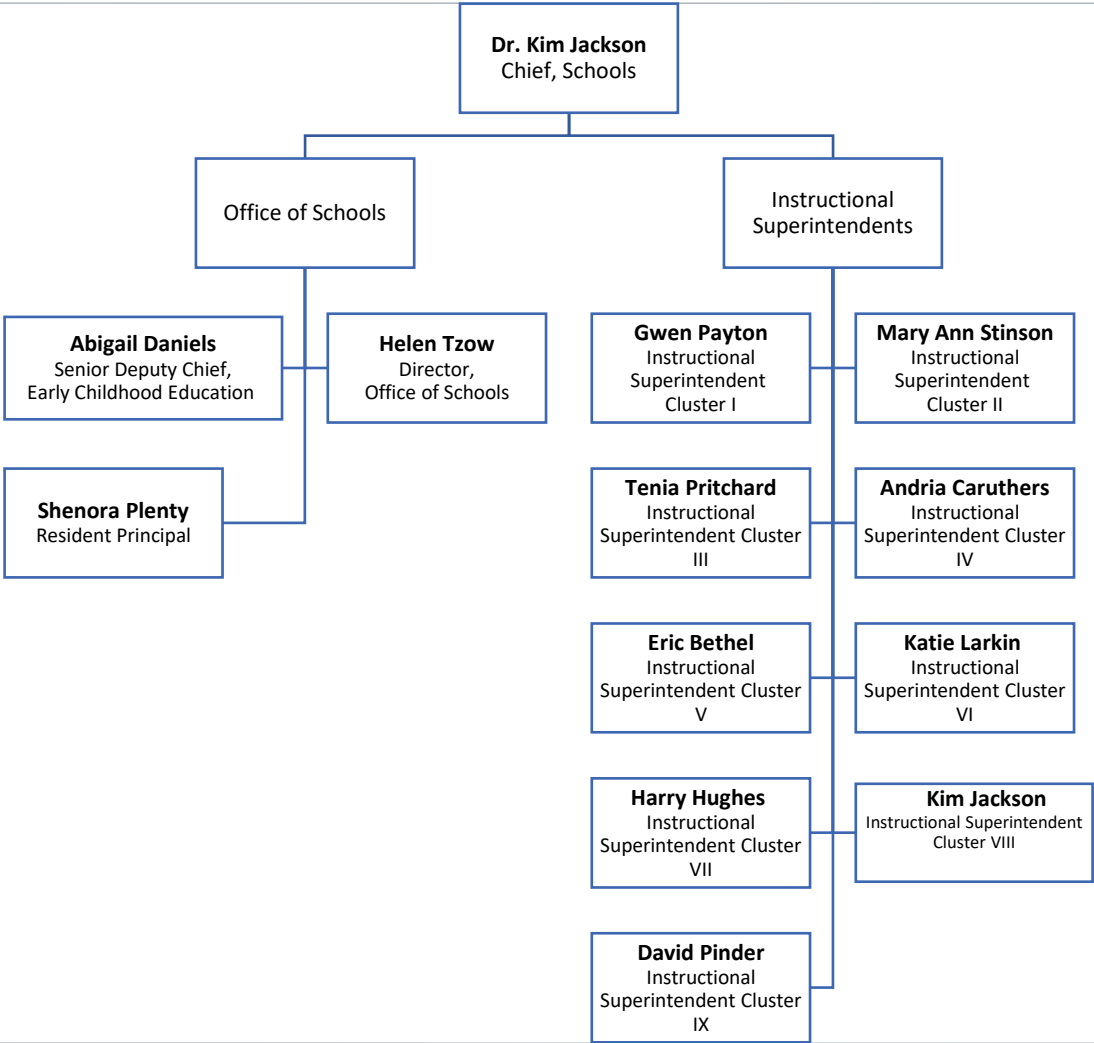

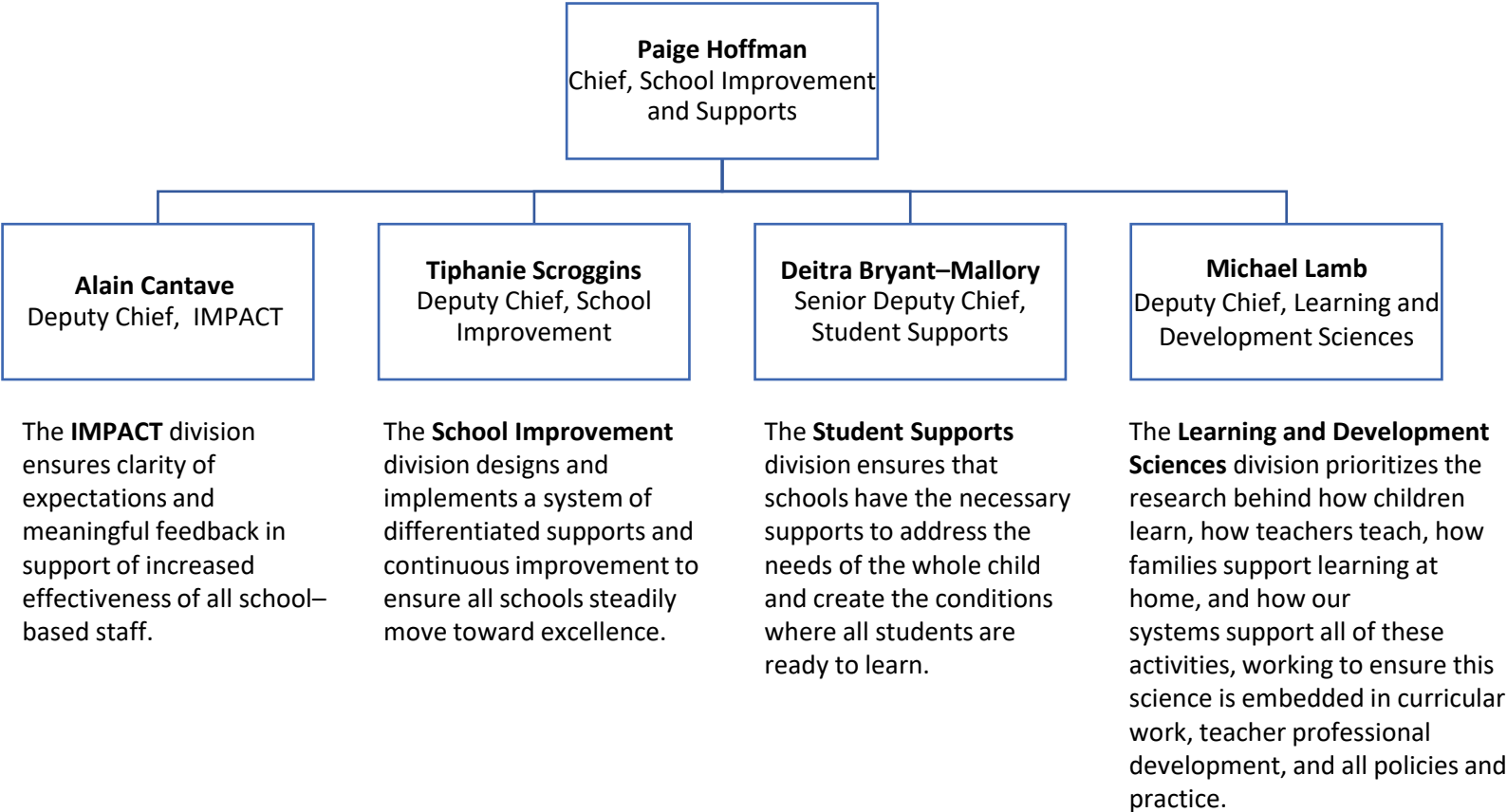

The **Director** of Schools support major initiatives across all DCPS schools to ensure all schools and departments are supported.



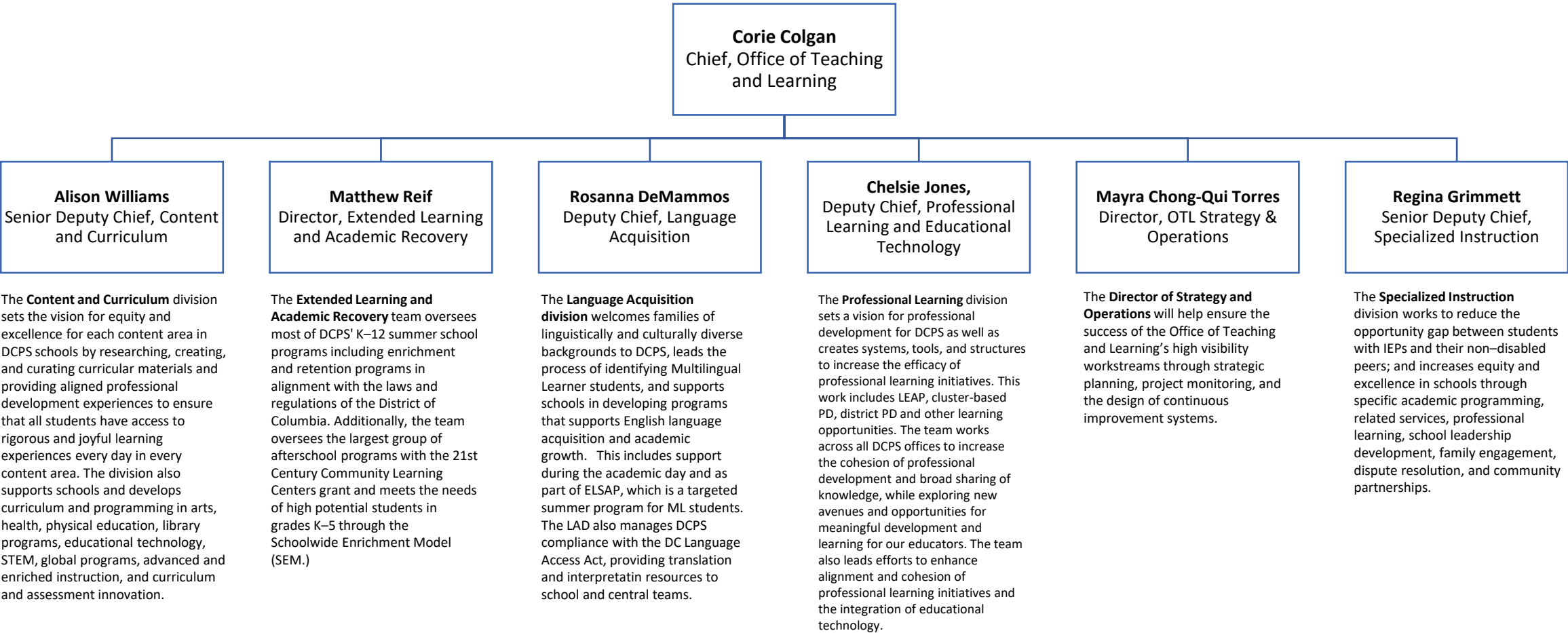

The **Special Education and Litigation** team represents DCPS in special education hearings, disciplinary appeals, and civil rights matters. The team also handles mediations and provides litigation support and statutory interpretation to OAG in appellate and complex civil litigation.

The **Labor and Employment, General Practice, and Policy division** is responsible for managing multiple streams of work. The **Labor and Employment** team represents DCPS in unemployment compensation hearings, union grievances, involving suspensions and terminations, immigration visa processing, drug/alcohol testing, hiring, reduction in force actions, and other labor and employment areas. The **General Practice** team manages and provides guidance to DCPS leaders and staff on a variety of diverse legal matters including, but not limited to, policy, federal education law, MOUs/MOAs, contract and procurement law, student privacy rights under FERPA, other student-related matters, FOIA, and government ethics.

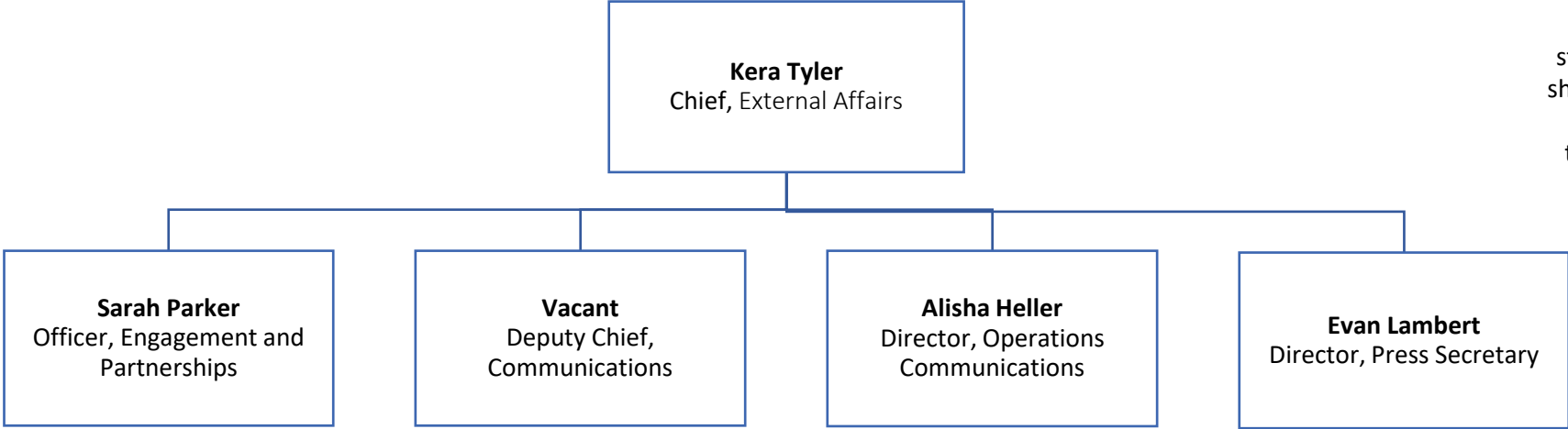
The **Labor Management and Employee Relations (LMER) - Employee Relations** team manages and supports staff through highly-sensitive and confidential employee relations, investigations, EEO matters including ADA and Sexual Harassment. Additionally, this team manages Central Services employee issues and agency-wide adverse action requests.

The **Labor Management and Employee Relations (LMER) - Labor Management** team manages and supports staff through highly-sensitive and confidential labor relations matters, liaising directly with DCPS' union partners. The team also manages the agency's Mandatory Drug and Alcohol Testing (MDAT) program and assists central services staff with employee performance matters.

The **Operations** division manages the priorities and operations within the office and oversees the development, finalization, and execution of OGC's departmental operating plan and budget. The team also supports the legal operations of the office by providing legal advice and counseling to stakeholders across the school system and administrative legal support.

The **Compliance** division works with all schools and central departments to ensure that operations and programming are compliant with applicable DCPS, District, and federal laws; regulations; and policies. The Compliance division manages grievances and complaints filed by students, parents and third parties, except EEOC.

# Office of External Affairs



The **Office of External Affairs** shines a light on the inspiring stories of DCPS students, staff, and schools and shares information with internal and external stakeholders to increase awareness of DCPS policies and initiatives.

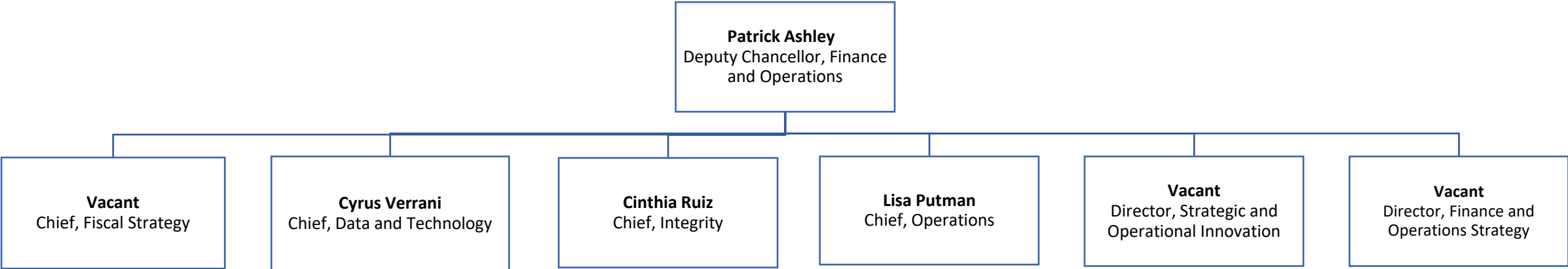
DCPS **Engagement and Partnerships** leads the district's strategy for partnering with families, communities, students, staff and partners at the district and school level in order to improve outcomes for every student by fostering collaborative partnerships between and among schools and the greater DC community.

The **Strategic Communications** team identifies and develops strategic and digital storytelling opportunities, oversees district-wide social media accounts and websites, and serves as a resource for school and Central Services-based teams.
