

A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Modification Nos. 4, 5, and 6 to Contract No. CW88823 with Mansfield Oil Company of Gainesville, Inc., and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the contract and modifications.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Modification Nos. 4, 5, and 6 to Contract No. CW88823 with Mansfield Oil Company of Gainesville, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2025”.

Sec. 2. (a) There exists an immediate need to approve Modifications Nos. 4, 5, and 6 to Contract No. CW88823 with Mansfield Oil Company of Gainesville, Inc., and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the modifications.

(b) On November 22, 2024, the Office of Contracting and Procurement (“OCP”), on behalf of the Department of Public Works, executed Modification No. 4 to exercise a partial option of option period three of Contract No. CW88823 with Mansfield Oil Company of Gainesville, Inc. to provide mid-grade, diesel, bio-diesel and ethanol fuel to the District fueling sites, in the not-to-exceed amount of \$1 million for the period from November 19, 2024 through January 18, 2025.

34 (c) Modification No. 5 extended the partial option period through March 19, 2025 in the  
35 not-to-exceed amount of \$1 million.

36 (d) Modification No. 6 exercised the remainder of option period three and increased the  
37 total not-to-exceed amount of the contract by \$4.3 million.

38 (e) Under section 451(b)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved  
39 December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51(b)(1)), Council approval is  
40 necessary since the modifications will increase the value of the contract to more than \$1 million  
41 during a 12-month period.

42 (f) Approval is necessary to allow the continuation of these vital services. Without this  
43 approval, Mansfield Oil Company of Gainesville, Inc. cannot be paid for goods and services  
44 provided in excess of \$1 million for the period from November 19, 2024 through June 30, 2025.

45 Sec. 3. The Council determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute  
46 emergency circumstances making it necessary that the Modification Nos. 4, 5, and 6 to Contract  
47 No. CW88823 with Mansfield Oil Company of Gainesville, Inc. Approval and Payment  
48 Authorization Emergency Act of 2025 be adopted after a single reading.

49 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
