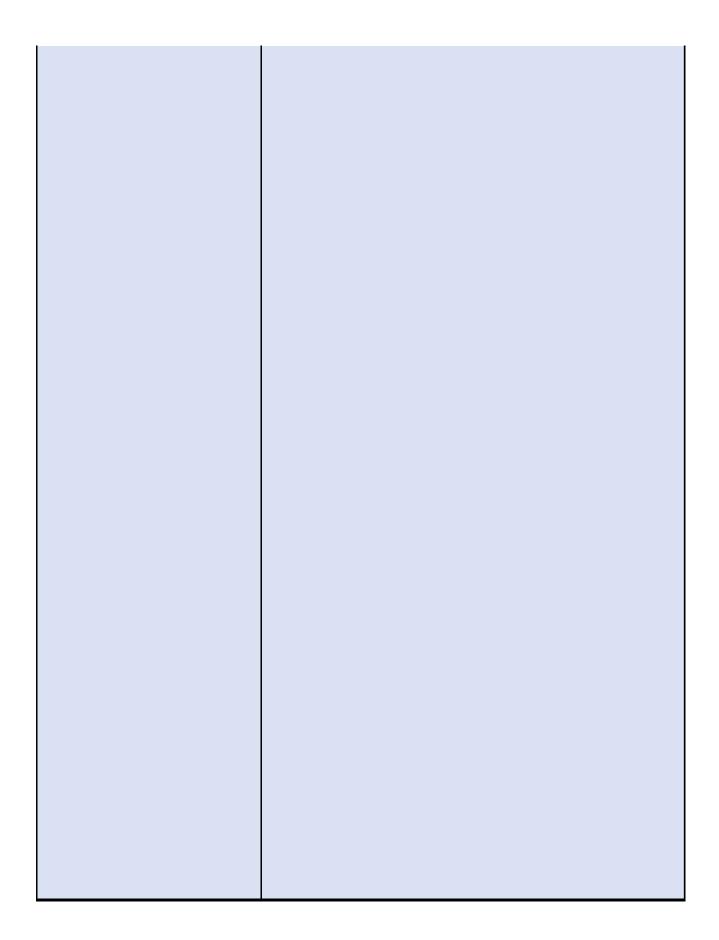

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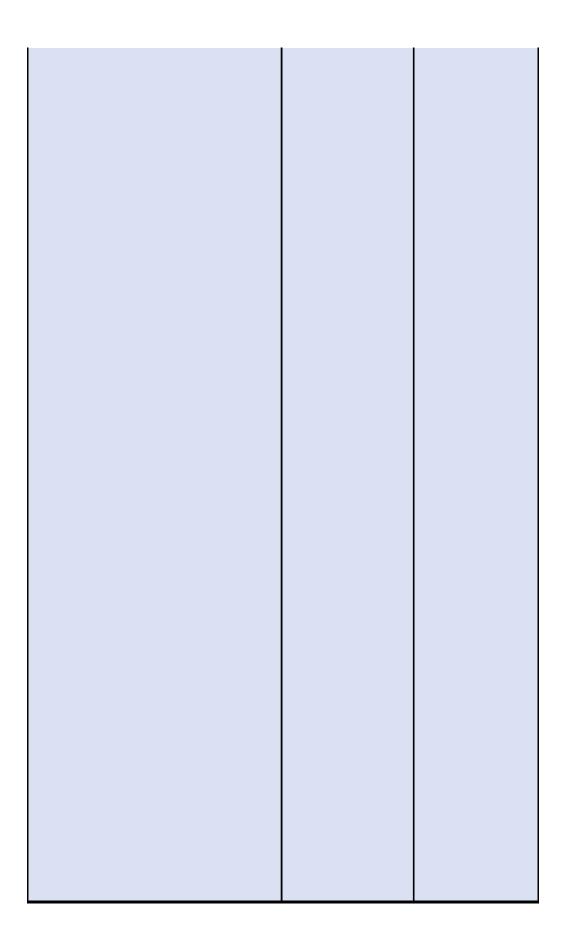

This is a request to reprogram \$7,000,000 of local operating funds within the Department of General Services (DGS) budget. This reprogramming is necessary to fund summer readiness facility initiatives for the District of Columbia Public Schools (DCPS).

Internal FY24 budget reprogramming to fund QPA Expenditures .

To fund various capital ineligible items as part of the renovations at certain swing campuses. Each time a new school that is undergoing a modernization moves in, DCPS performs upgrades to the swing campus to make program-specific modifications.

DCPS requested to reprogram FY 2024 capital paygo funds in the amount of \$3,100,000.00 from the DCPS capital budget to the DGS operating budget to enable the funding of capital ineligible items for various small capital projects and modernization projects. The funds were needed to to enable the funding of capital ineligible items for the Browne ES and Thomas ES modernization projects.

These funds are needed to help support rising operational costs in administering DGS's large portfolio. The funds will provide addition contractual support for finance and procurement operations. The services are ineligibe for capital expenditures and must be reprogrammed to the operating budget.

This reprogramming is necessary to fund design services for the reviewing stands of the January 2025 Presidential Inauguration.

The funds will be used for items that have been deemed ineligible for capital expenditure, such as Carpet Tile.

For the funding of ineligible items which are need for project completion. This includes CCTV cameras and office furniture.

The funds are needed to enable the funding of ineligible items for several projects implemented on behalf of the Department of Parks & Recreation

To enable the funding of ineligible items for various small capital projects and modernization projects for multiple DC Public Schools (DCPS).

To fund construction support services necessary for the operations of DGS' multi-billion-dollar capital portfolio. These services include: invoice processing, legal services, contracting and procurement, master and cost loaded scheduling, IT systems licenses (ProjectTeam), IT support and maintenance and building automation support. This reprogramming will also support the funding of ongoing FCAs (\$1,000,000.00).

All of these above items are ineligible for capital expenditure and must be reprogrammed to the operating budget.

This reprogramming request will fund a contract modification due to an increased scope of work. Some of the items being funded include increased costs of material due to COVID delays, additional site testing and remediation, and architectural engineering services.

This reprogramming will fund the procurement of capital ineligible furniture, fixture, and equipment (FFE) items for Firehouses 3, 12, and 19.

The reprogramming will fund the purchase of mirrors, carpet, bathroom accessories such as ADA grab bars, hand dryers, soap dispensers, and trash dispensers, all of which are required to complete the project. These items are ineligible for capital funding and must be reprogrammed to the operating budget for purchase.

This request to reprogram capital Paygo budget in the amount of \$900,000 is needed for external management services for DGS' capital projects portfolio. These services include invoice processing, legal services, contracting and procurement, master and cost loaded scheduling, IT systems licenses (ProjectTeam), IT support and maintenance and building automation support. These items are ineligible for capital funding/expenditure and must be reprogrammed to the operating budget.

The reprogramming will fund the purchase of furniture, fixtures and equipment (FF&E) items that are needed for the McMillian project. These items are ineligible for capital funding and must be reprogrammed to the operating budget for purchase.

To fund construction support services necessary for the operations of DGS' multi-billion-dollar capital portfolio. These services include: invoice processing, legal services, contraction and procurement, master and cost loaded scheduling, IT systems licenses (ProjectTeam), IT support and maintenance and building automation support. All of thes items are ineligible for capital expenditure and must be reprogrammed to the operating budget.

This is a request to reprogram capital PAYGO funds (after a PAYGO swap by EOM) in the amount of \$41,258.00 from the Department of Youth Rehabilitation Services (DYRS) Youth Services Center (YSC) capital project (100230-AM0.SH740C.YSC SECURITY ENTRANCE IMPROVEMENTS) to the Department of General Services (DGS) operating budget to enable the funding of ineligible items.

Reprogramming is necessary to move funds in the correct budget attribute line in order to setup a project for OCTO (seller agency). DGS will be providing the funds as a buyer agency to redesign its public-facing website.

This reprogramming will fund two feasibility studies for Senior Wellness Centers (SWC) in Ward 2 and Ward 3. These services are not eligible for capital expenditure.

The reprogramming is necessary to fund programmatic and administrative support costs that are generally not direct labor costs applied against individual capital projects as capital expenditures, and thus deemed capital ineligible per the District's capital eligibility guidelines. These administrative support services can include but are not limited to software, contractors, legal, contracts & procurement, financial, and other general support services necessary for the successful operations of DGS's multi-billion-dollar capital portfolio.

Pursuant to a Lease Agreement between the District of Columbia and Eagle Academy Public Charter School ("Eagle Academy") dated October 17, 2011 (the "Lease"), Eagle Academy leases the Districtowned property at 3400 Wheeler Road, SE (the "Property") for the operation of a public charter school, through 2036 with options to extend the lease through 2086. However, in August 2024 Eagle Academy relinquished its charter and ceased school operations. Subsequently, on August 23, 2024, Eagle Academy's lender, John Marshall Bank (the "Bank"), notified the District that Eagle Academy had defaulted on its loan from the Bank and that the Bank intended to initiate foreclosure proceedings. The Bank's loan to Eagle Academy provided funds for the construction and modernization of the Property including the school building, which has been completed.

DCDS has identified the Property as a school huilding

and grounds that can serve as a swing campus for public schools undergoing modernizations in Wards 7 and 8. Therefore, the District wants to exercise its rights under the Lease to acquire Eagle's leasehold interest (and thereby have the property for District use) prior to the Bank foreclosing and potentially transferring the leasehold interest to a third party. Per the terms of the Lease, the District has the right to fully satisfy the outstanding loan amount due to the Bank on or before October 22, 2024, which will extinguish any interest of the Bank in the Property. It is estimated that the amount owed as of October 22,2024, inclusive of principal, interest, penalties and fees, is \$13,671,344.18.

For Browne Education Campus (100267; AM0.YY108C.BROWNE EC MODERNIZATION) capital ineligible items including, but not limited to non-eligible furniture and equipment, audio/visual items, security cameras, and artwork.

The funds are needed to procure and install the critical Capital Ineligible FF&E required to fulfill the programmatic scope.

The reprogramming is necessary to fund the planned services related to the agency's facility condition assessments initiative. Per the District's capital eligibility guidelines, facility condition assessments are only eligible for an approved capital project in the current approved 6-year CIP; therefore, a reprogramming of these capital PAYGO funds to the agency's operating budget is necessary,

The funds are needed for the following purposes:

\$206,887.21 for Martin Luther King Elementary (100129; AMO.PK337C.MARTIN LUTHER KING ES MODERNIZATOIN) for the early termination of the power purchase agreement that governs the rooftop solar panels. The cost is based on the termination fee included in the power purchase agreement between the Department of General Services and the solar provider. The termination is necessary to allow for the panels to be removed from the roof and allow construction activities onsite to commence. It has been determined that it is not feasible to operate the panels while construction occurs on site.

The funds are needed for the following purposes:

\$1,000,000.00 for the non-capital eligible elements of the Burroughs Modular Swing Campus, which will be built on the field at Burroughs Elementary School.

The majority of this cost will be the covered walkways to and between the trailers, but will also include non-eligible furniture, fixtures and equipment, audio/visual equipment and security equipment.

\$250,000.00 for improvements to DC Prep, which is a new swing campus that will serve schools in Wards 7 and 8. The costs will include non-eligible furniture, fixtures and equipment, audio/visual equipment and security equipment.

\$250,000 for improvements to the Meyer School, to which Brent Elementary School students and staff will move in Summer 2025. The costs will include repairs, painting and non-eligible furniture, fixtures and equipment.
