RE: Request to agendize measure for March 3rd, 2026, Legislative Meeting.

Please include the following legislation on the March 3rd, 2026, Legislative Meeting agenda.

Emergency Legislation

- **Full Accountability in Arrest Reporting Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2026**
- **Full Accountability in Arrest Reporting Emergency Amendment Act of 2026**
- **Full Accountability in Arrest Reporting Temporary Amendment Act of 2026**

This emergency would require MPD officers to fully document who is present and who uses force at an arrest, including federal officers, by listing the name, badge or other identifying number, and employing agency of every officer on scene in arrest reports and probable cause affidavits, noting whether any officer used force and describing that force, and recording the number of officers who refuse to identify themselves. It would also require that when a federal law enforcement officer commits a serious use of force in the presence of MPD and the incident is captured on MPD body worn camera, the Mayor must publicly release all relevant MPD footage and a description of the incident within 5 business days, pursuant to consent provisions.
