A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

1 To amend the Robert F. Kennedy Memorial Stadium and the District of Columbia National Guard  
2 Armory Public Safety Act of 1977, on a temporary basis, to include the Downtown Arena  
3 and the Southeast Arena in the prohibition on unauthorized entry onto a playing surface.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this  
6 act may be cited as the “Arena Safety Conformity Temporary Amendment Act of 2026”.

7 Sec. 2. The Robert F. Kennedy Memorial Stadium and the District of Columbia National  
8 Guard Armory Public Safety Act of 1977, effective November 11, 1977 (D.C. Law 2-37; D.C.  
9 Official Code § 3-341 *et seq.*), is amended as follows:

10 (a) Section 3a (D.C. Official Code § 3-342.01) is amended as follows:

11 (1) A new paragraph (1A) is added to read as follows:

12 “(1A) “Downtown Arena” means a sports and entertainment arena located at 601  
13 F St. N.W.”.

14 (2) A new paragraph (3) is added to read as follows:

15 “(3) “Southeast Arena” means a sports and entertainment arena located at 1100  
16 Oak Dr. S.E.”.

17 (b) Section 4b (D.C. Official Code § 3-343.02) is amended as follows:

18 (1) New subsections (b-2) and (b-3) are added to read as follows:

19 “(b-2) Unless expressly authorized by the operator of the Downtown Arena, or its duly  
20 authorized agents, no person shall at any time enter onto any portion of the playing surface  
21 within the Downtown Arena.”.

22 “(b-3) Unless expressly authorized by the Washington Convention and Sports Authority,  
23 the lessee or operator of the Southeast Arena, or their duly authorized agents, no person shall at  
24 any time enter onto any portion of the playing surface within the Southeast Arena.”.

25 (2) Subsection (c) is amended to read as follows:

26 “(c) For the purposes of this section, the term “playing field” or “playing surface”, as  
27 applicable, means the area encompassed by the seating facilities within the Robert F. Kennedy  
28 Memorial Stadium, the Baseball Stadium, the Soccer Stadium, the Downtown Arena, or the  
29 Southeast Arena, as such seating facilities may be arranged from time to time.”.

30 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

31 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Budget Director as the fiscal impact  
32 statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved  
33 October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

34 Sec. 4. Effective date.

35 (a) This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by  
36 the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as  
37 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24,  
38 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of  
39 Columbia Register.

40 (b) This act shall expire after 225 days of its having taken effect.
