A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to confirm the appointment of Vince Micone to the District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority Board of Directors.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority Board of Directors Vince Micone Confirmation Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2026”.

Sec. 2. (a) The District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority (“DC Water”) is governed by a Board of Directors (“Board”), consisting of 11 principal and 11 alternate members. Six board members must be “District residents, appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the Council.”

(b) On December 15, 2025, Proposed Resolution 26-0486, the “District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority Board of Directors Vince Micone Confirmation Resolution of 2026,” was introduced by Chairman Mendelson at the request of the Mayor. The legislation would confirm Vince Micone as an alternate District resident member of the Board.

30 (c) PR26-486 was referred to the Committee on Transportation and the Environment on
31 January 6, 2026 and the Committee held a public roundtable on the measure on March 20, 2026.
32 The Committee did not consider and vote on PR26-486 at its March 24, 2026 Additional Meeting.

33 (d) Without Council action, PR26-0486 will be deemed disapproved on April 7, 2026. If
34 the Council does not act to confirm Mr. Micone’s nomination at the March 31, 2026 Legislative
35 Meeting and PR26-0586 is disapproved, there will be a vacant seat on the Board reserved for
36 District residents.

37 Sec. 3. The Council determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute
38 emergency circumstances making it necessary that the “District of Columbia Water and Sewer
39 Authority Board of Directors Vince Micone Confirmation Emergency Approval Resolution of
40 2026” be adopted on an emergency basis.

41 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
