I request that the following measures be placed on the agenda for the March 31 2026 Legislative Meeting:

Measures Approved by the Committee

- **PR26-0482, the “Green Finance Authority Board Monica Warren-Jones Confirmation Resolution of 2026”**

Proposed Resolution 26-0482, the “Green Finance Authority Board Monica Warren-Jones Confirmation Resolution of 2026”, was introduced on December 15, 2025, by Chairman Mendelson at the request of the Mayor. This measure would confirm the reappointment of Monica Warren-Jones as a voting member of the Green Finance Authority Board of Directors, established by section 203 of the Green Finance Authority Establishment Act of 2018, effective August 22, 2018 (D.C. Law 22-155; D.C. Official Code§ 8-173.21), with experience in affordable housing or community development, for a term to end July 9, 2029.

- **PR26-0483, the “Green Finance Authority Board Anthony Washington Confirmation Resolution of 2026”**

Proposed Resolution 26-0483, the “Green Finance Authority Board Anthony Washington Confirmation Resolution of 2026”, was introduced on December 15, 2025 by Chairman Mendelson at the request of the Mayor. This measure would confirm the reappointment of Anthony Washington as a voting member of the Green Finance Authority Board of Directors, established by section 203 of the Green Finance Authority Establishment Act of 2018, effective August 22, 2018 (D.C. Law 22-155; D.C. Official Code§ 8-173.21), with experience in affordable housing or community development, for a term to end July 9, 2029.

- **PR26-0485, the “District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority Board of Directors Rachna Butani Bhatt Confirmation Resolution of 2025”**

Proposed Resolution 26-0485, the “District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority Board of Directors Rachna Butani Bhatt Confirmation Resolution of 2025,” was introduced on December 16, 2025, by Chairman Mendelson at the request of the Mayor. The legislation would reconfirm Rachna Butani Bhatt as a principal District resident member of the Board of Directors of the District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority.

- **Proposed Resolution 26-0487, the “District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority Board of Directors Dr. Jimmy Ortiz Confirmation Resolution of 2026”**

Proposed Resolution 26-0487, the “District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority Board of Directors Dr. Jimmy Ortiz Confirmation Resolution of 2026,” was introduced on December 16, 2025, by Chairman Mendelson at the request of the Mayor. The legislation would confirm Dr. Jimmy Ortiz as an alternate district resident member of the Board of Directors of the District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority.

Ceremonial Measures

- **“Sandra Mattavous-Frye Recognition Resolution of 2026”**

Ms. Sandra Mattavous-Frye has served with the Office of People’s Council (“OPC”) for more than 30 years, including as Deputy People’s Counsel, Director of Litigation, and Energy Section Trial Supervisor. Following 29 years of advocacy, she was appointed by Mayor Vincent Gray and unanimously confirmed by the Council of the District of Columbia in 2011, and has served in that role since then. This ceremonial resolution commemorates her accomplishments in that role in light of her upcoming and well-deserved retirement.

Emergency Measures

- **“District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority Board of Directors Vince Micone Confirmation Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2026”**
- **“District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority Board of Directors Vince Micone Confirmation Emergency Approval Resolution of 2026”**

The District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority (“DC Water”) is governed by a Board of Directors (“Board”), consisting of 11 principal and 11 alternate members. Six board members must be “District residents, appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the Council.

On December 15, 2025, Proposed Resolution 26-0486, the “District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority Board of Directors Vince Micone Confirmation Resolution of 2026,” was by Chairman Mendelson at the request of the Mayor. The legislation would confirm Vince Micone as an alternate District resident member of the Board of Directors of the District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority. PR26-486 was referred to the Committee on Transportation and the Environment on January 6, 2026 and the Committee held a public roundtable on the measure on March 20, 2026. The Committee did not consider and vote on PR26-486 at its March 24, 2026 Additional Meeting.

Without Council action, PR26-0486 will be deemed disapproved on April 7, 2026. If the Council does not act to confirm Mr. Micone’s nomination at the March 31, 2026 Legislative Meeting, PR26-0586 will be deemed disapproved, resulting in a vacancy on the Board.
