A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Modification No. M003 to Contract No. DCRL-2026-C-0024 with Crawford Consulting and Mental Health Service, Inc. to provide community-based residential and social services and to authorize payment for the services received under these modifications.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Modification No. M003 to Contract No. DCRL-2026-C-0024 with Crawford Consulting and Mental Health Service, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2026”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51), and notwithstanding the requirements of section 202 of the Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18-371; D.C. Official Code § 2-352.02), the Council approves proposed Modification No. M003 to Contract No. DCRL-2026-C-0024 with Crawford Consulting and Mental Health Service, Inc. to provide community-based residential and social services in the total not-to-exceed amount of \$1,774,850.84 for the services received under the proposed modification.

35 Sec. 3. The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement provided by the Chief Financial
36 Officer as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative
37 Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-
38 301.47a).

39 Sec. 4. This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto
40 by the Mayor, action by the Council to override that veto), and shall remain in effect for no
41 longer than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia
42 in section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87
43 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
