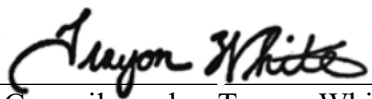
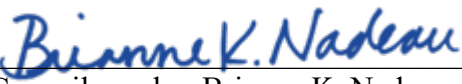

30 WHEREAS, L. S. Caldwell & Associates, Inc. has spent the last three and a half decades
31 operating as an economic development engine, community advocate, and trusted business
32 partner across the District, contributing to the growth and equity of the District's economy;

43 programs, local hiring requirements, and CBE subcontracting compliance for essential
44 community healthcare infrastructure; and DC Water critical utility and clean water
45 modernization initiatives, where LSC managed workforce development, CBE tracking, and
46 compliance services across Ward 8;

WHEREAS, L. S. Caldwell & Associates, Inc. has directly expanded job training, contracting, and apprenticeship opportunities for Ward 8 residents and small businesses;

WHEREAS, L. S. Caldwell & Associates, Inc. managed contracting, Certified Business Enterprise compliance, local hiring, and community outreach for the \$62 million Ward 4 Short-Term Family Housing project;
