A RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Proposed Modification No. M003 to Contract No. DCRL-2026-C-0024 with Crawford Consulting and Mental Health Service, Inc. to provide community-based residential and social services, and to authorize payment for the services received under these modifications.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Modification No. M003 to Contract No. DCRL-2026-C-0024 Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2026”.

Sec. 2. (a) There exists a need to approve Modification No. M003 to Contract No. DCRL-2026-C-0024 with Crawford Consulting and Mental Health Service, Inc. to provide community-based residential and social services, and to authorize payment for the services received under these modifications.

(b) On May 11, 2026, The Child and Family Services Agency (“CFSA”) executed Contract No. DCRL-2026-C-0024 with Crawford Consulting and Mental Health Service, Inc. to provide community-based residential and social services in the District of Columbia in the not-to-exceed amount of \$691,648.03 for the period of May 12, 2026 through September 30, 2026.

35 (c) By Modification No. M001, issued on May 19, 2026, CFSA decreased the not-to-
36 exceed amount of \$691,648.03 to a not-to-exceed total of \$690,762.37.

37 (d) By Modification No. M002, issued on July 27, 2026, CFSA incorporated a revised
38 price schedule.

39 (e) Proposed Modification No. M003 will exercise option year one for the period of
40 October 1, 2026 through September 30, 2027 in the not-to-exceed amount by \$1,774,850.84.

41 (f) Under section 451(b)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved
42 December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51(b)(1)), Council approval is
43 necessary since the modifications will increase the value of the contract to more than \$1
44 million during a 12-month period.

45 (g) Approval is necessary to allow the continuation of these vital services. Without
46 this approval, Crawford Consulting and Mental Health Service, Inc. cannot be paid for
47 services provided in excess of \$1,000,000.

48 Sec. 3. The Council determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2
49 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the Modification No. M003 to
50 Contract No. DCRL-2026-C-0024 with Crawford Consulting and Mental Health Service,
51 Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2026 be adopted after a single
52 reading.

53 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
