

A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To require, on a temporary basis, the Department of Small and Local Business Development to award a \$1 million dollar grant in Fiscal year 2027 to the Duke District Business Improvement District.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Duke District BID Grantmaking Temporary Amendment Act of 2026”.

Sec. 2. Section 2a of the Performance Parking Pilot Zone Act of 2008, effective September 14, 2011 (D.C. Law 19-21; D.C. Official Code § 50-2531.01), is amended as follows:

(a) Subsection (c) is amended as follows:

(1) Paragraph (4)(A) is amended to read as follows:

“(4)(A) Notwithstanding paragraph (3) of this subsection, at the beginning of Fiscal Year 2027, the Department of Small and Local Business Development shall award a grant in the amount of \$1 million from the Fund to support the Duke Business Improvement District Corporation, d/b/a Duke District BID to improve conditions for property owners, businesses, residents and visitors within the Greater Shaw/U Street area.”.

Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

37 (a) This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by
38 the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review
39 as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
40 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
41 Columbia Register.

42 (b) This act shall expire after 225 days of its having taken effect.
