A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Modification Nos. M04, M05 and M06 to Contract No. CW106884 with See Forever Foundation, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the modifications.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Modification Nos. M04, M05 and M06 to Contract No. CW106884 with See Forever Foundation Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2026”.

Sec. 2. (a) There exists an immediate need to approve Modification Nos. M04, M05 and M06 to Contract No. CW106884 with See Forever Foundation, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the modifications.

(b) By Modification No. M04, issued on July 7, 2026, the Office of Contracting and Procurement (“OCP”), on behalf of the Department of Youth Rehabilitation Services (“DYRS”), exercised a partial option of option year three of Contract No. CW106884 with See Forever Foundation to provide an education program to youth who are in the custody of the DYRS at the Youth Services Center in the not-to-exceed amount of \$1 million for the period July 7, 2026 through September 30, 2026.

33 (c) By Modification No. M05, issued on July 28, 2026, OCP exercised another partial
34 option extending the period of performance through October 7, 2026 at no additional cost.

35 (d) Proposed Modification No. M06 will exercise the remainder of option year three and
36 increase the not-to-exceed amount by \$2,968,957.85, to a total not-to-exceed amount of
37 \$3,968,957.85.

38 (e) Under section 451(b)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved
39 December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51(b)(1)), Council approval is
40 necessary since the modifications will increase the value of the contract to more than \$1 million
41 during a 12-month period.

42 (f) Approval is necessary to allow the continuation of these vital services. Without this
43 approval, See Forever Foundation cannot be paid for goods and services provided in excess of \$1
44 million for the period from July 7, 2026 through July 6, 2027.

45 Sec. 3. The Council determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute
46 emergency circumstances making it necessary that the Modification Nos. M04, M05 and M06 to
47 Contract No. CW106884 with See Forever Foundation Approval and Payment Authorization
48 Emergency Act of 2026 be adopted after a single reading.

49 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
